

What is Discrimination?

- * When similar or better qualified applicant...
 - * Poes not get job applied for
 - * Gets job below qualification
 - * Receives lower pay for same job

What is Discrimination?

* Unequal treatment or behavior toward members of different groups

What is Discrimination?

- * Pistinction, exclusion, restriction or preference based on group membership impairing human rights
 - * Impose burdens not imposed on others
 - * Withhold or limit access to benefits available to others

Examples of Discrimination

- * Individual
- * E.g., behaviors like different performance ratings for members of different groups all else being equal

Examples of Discrimination

- * Institutional
- * Policies, practices, procedures that disadvantage members of some groups
- * Unequal representation in upper & middle layers of administration, economic & media institutions

What are stereotypes

- * Associating members of certain groups with certain characteristics
 - * E.g., Perceived to be alike in some way (i.e. have similar traits)
 - * E.g., Most Asians are "smart"

What are stereotypes

- * Can be positive or negative
- * Can be true/false of group &/
 individual
- * Implications for functionality

Examples of Stereotypes

- * Confusing one member of group for another
 - * Believing them to be similar in personality/behavior
 - * E.g., editors vs. journalists

Examples of Stereotypes

- * Assuming characteristics of individual based on group membership
- * E.g., assuming your are nanny because you are Filipino, Assuming non-Whites are not Canadian;

What are not stereotypes?

- * Prejudice
 - * Negative feelings (e.g., dislike) toward someone because of group they belong to
- * Discrimination
 - * Behavior/outcome

What are not stereotypes?

- * Culturally valid characteristics
- * e.g., collectivism
 - * Asians score higher (in general) on collectivism,
 - * Any single Asian may not score higher than a non-Asian on collectivism

What are not stereotypes?

- * Negative attitudes
 - * Negative evaluations & feelings
 - * E.g., Evaluations: They are bad...
 - * Feelings: I hate...
