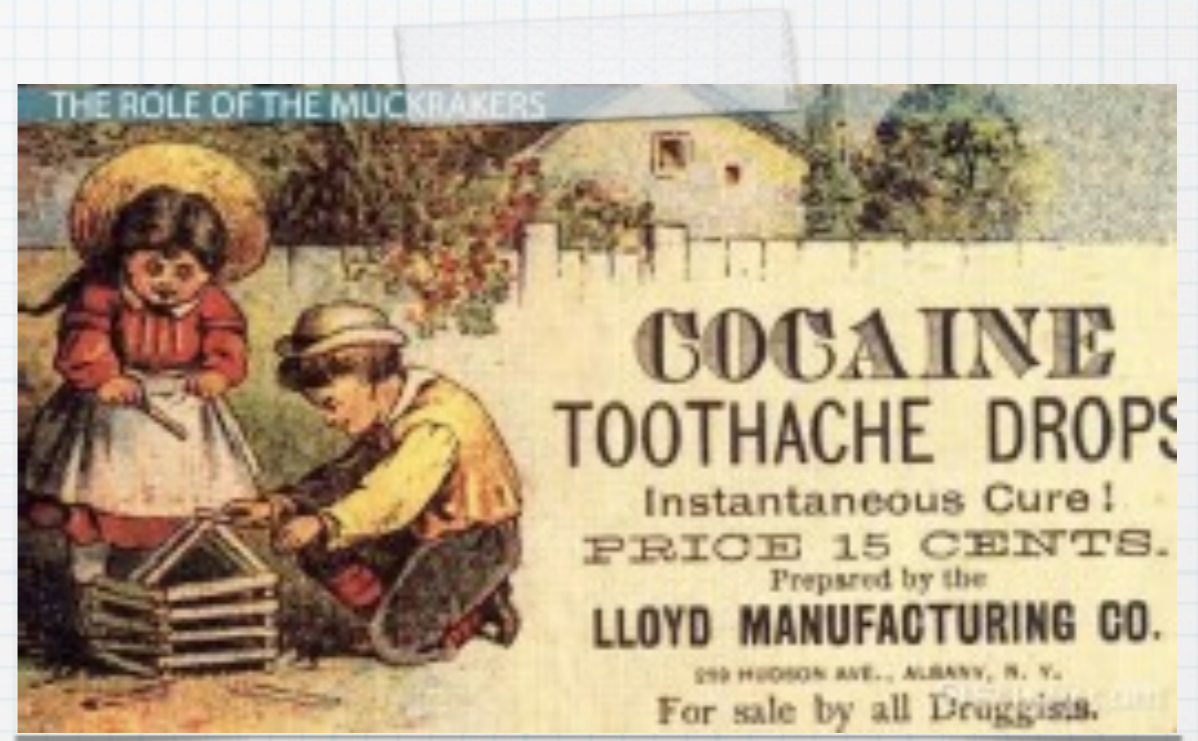


A History of Unethical Research

Pure Food and Drug Act

- * In the USA, before the Pure Food and Drug Act was passed in 1906 there were no regulations on performing research on humans.



Tuskegee Syphilis Study (1932-72)

- * 600 black men over 40, 400 had syphilis yet were not told they had it.
- * Denied treatment
- * Many died during study.
- * President Clinton apologized to all of those affected and their families



Nuremberg Code (POST WWII)

- * Laws put in place after the Nazi experiments of WWII were uncovered
- * Researchers now must have consent from their human subjects



Stanley Milgram Experiment (1962)

- * Obedience to authority
- * Electric Shock Consequences
- * Connections to WWII
- * Yale University

- * Stanford University
